- Sparkler shaped tips
- Cream striped

Name: Sparkler Sedge

Full Name: Carex phyllocephalla 'Sparkler'

Flower: Short brown racemes in summer

Leaf: Distinctive cream striped leaves giving a sparkler shape at the tips of the stems

Mature Size: 0.5m H x 0.5m S/Clump forming

Preferred Location: Woodland garden/Garden borders

Likes: Semi shade and moist soil

Dislikes: Exposed position or temperatures below -5°C

Grown in: Ireland

Carex 'Whirling Sparkler' is a striking member of the Sedge family with its cream striped leaves that give a sparkler shape at the tip of the stems. It is a clump forming sedge that prefers moist soil conditions in a sheltered and shady part of your garden. It is a low maintenance plant that is ideal for planting in large groups in your garden.
