Fascicularia bicolor

**Exotic Foliage – Compact Form
Easy Care – Indoors and Outdoors**

Fascicularia bicolor is a highly colourful plant with an exotic appearance. It originates in Chile where mature plants produce metallic blue flowers from the centre of the rosette during summer. The leaves are green on the surface and pale brown underneath, the innermost leaves are usually brightly coloured as plants prepare to flower. Fascicularia bicolor is an ideal plant for large containers and its exotic tolerant foliage will give great value winter and summer giving the added bonus of Scarlet Pineapple like flowers in the Autumn on mature plants. This plant is hardy from -10°C -12°C needing well-drained soil and a sheltered location to look its best.
