### **Libertia peregrinans 'Goldleaf'**

Dramatically coloured foliage in autumn and winter, this species forms a clumping spreading habit, stiff leaves with a prominent orange midrib. 'Gold Leaf' is an ideal plant for using in mixed planters for Autumn, Winter and early Spring arrangements and will give outstanding impact for a long period of time year after year if planted in the garden. The plant spreads slowly by underground rhizomes and can be easily dug out if it encroaches into areas where it is unwanted.

#### **CARE & HANDLING**

*Hardiness:* Hardy to  $-8^{\circ}\text{C}$  for short periods.

*Bloom:* Small amounts of white star like flowers from mid spring.

*Foliage:* Upright, stiff olive green foliage changing to orange and deep russet colours from autumn onwards.

*Habit:* Compact upright habit 0,5x0,5m.

*Propagation:* Tissue Culture, division.

*Culture:* Moist, fertile soils. Full sun to light shade.
