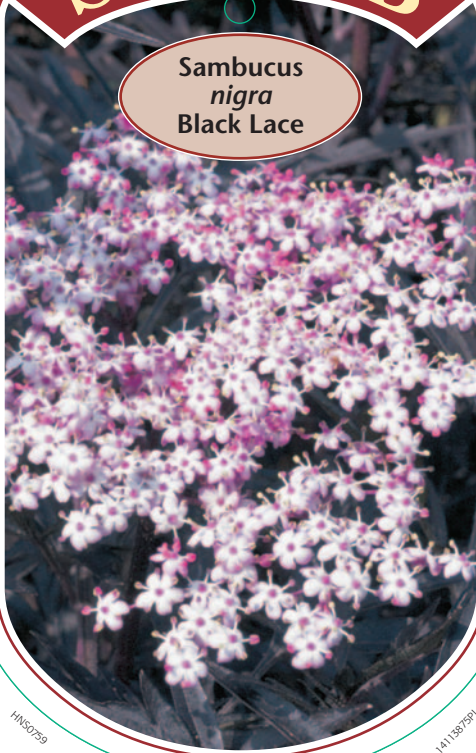

Sambucus nigra f. porphyrophylla Black Lace

(*syn. nigra Eva^{EU}*)

With exotic dark foliage and gorgeous pink flower clusters, this is a truly outstanding elderflower with the added bonus of Autumn berries suitable for wine making.

Height and Spread in 10 years:

Up to 3m (10ft), if not pruned.

Position:

Sun or partial shade, any fertile soil, chalk tolerant.

Planting:

Water thoroughly before planting. Plant keeping the root-ball surface level with the surrounding soil, filling the hole with soil mixed with compost and a sprinkling of bone meal. Firm well and water in. Keep moist until well established.

Plant Care:

Prune to ground in Winter every 2-3 years, or take out old wood.

This plant is protected by Plant Breeders Rights under Nr. EU13679. Propagation is prohibited without a licence.
