BLOOM LEAF:

- Black, finely cut leaves
- Creamy white flowers



SIZE:

- 3.0m H x 2.0m S
- Upright growth



USE:

- Garden plant
- Free flower hedging



Name:	Elderberry
Full Name:	Sambucus nigra 'Black Lace' PBR
Flower:	Pinkish flower buds followed by clusters of small creamy white flowers in June and red/black berries in the autumn
Leaf:	finely cut black, deciduous leaves
Mature Size:	3.0mH x 2.0mS/Upright growth
Preferred Location:	Free flower hedging/Garden plant
Likes:	Full sun or partial shade/Rich, moist soils
Dislikes:	Water logged soil and temperatures below -25°C
Grown in:	Ireland

Sambucus 'Black Lace' is a stunning foliage plant and extremely adaptable to the environment. It is easy to grow, can be pruned to fit in most garden situations and sets year round accents through its black foliage, the pink flower buds followed by creamy white flowers and the red and black berries. The berries are edible and can be used the same than other elderberries for making jam or wine. It is also extremely winter hardy.
