

Sambucus 'Sutherland Gold'



BLOOM LEAF:

- Golden, finely cut leaves
- Creamy yellow flowers



SIZE:

- 2.0m H x 1.5m S
- Upright, bushy growth



USE:

- Garden border
- Patio container



Name:	Golden Elderberry
Full Name:	Sambucus racemosa 'Sutherland Gold'
Flower:	Clusters of creamy yellow flowers in June followed by red berries in the autumn
Leaf:	Deeply cut bronze young leaves turning golden yellow
Mature Size:	2.0mH x 1.5mS/Upright, bushy growth
Preferred Location:	Garden border/Patio container
Likes:	Full sun or partial shade/Rich, moist soils
Dislikes:	Water logged soil and temperatures below -25°C
Grown in:	Ireland

Sambucus racemosa 'Sutherland Gold' is a delicate looking, but tough garden plant. It suits most soil conditions, but prefers well drained, moist garden soils and a half shaded location to perform best. With its compact bushy growth it can also be kept easily in a patio container. The finely cut leaves resemble a bit *Japanese Maples*, but this plant is a lot easier to grow, less maintenance and winter hardier.
