

RESTIO'S



Elegia capensis

A stunning fast growing architectural Restio from South Africa. The stems reach about 2m in height with slender branches arranged in whorls at the nodes. Golden brown flower heads are produced in the Spring followed by dark brown seed heads. Excellent for flower arrangements. Looks great when planted next to a pond and prefers moisture in the Summer. Plant in full sun in well drained moisture retentive soil.

Chondropetalum tectorum

This popular Restio forms a very attractive, tufted clump of stunning foliage, reaching about 1.5m in height and spread. Slender, compact spikes have brown bracts when flowering in the Autumn. Grows in any well-drained soil in full sun. Great for flower arranging and perfect for patio containers.
